PUBLIC NOTICE

ABANDONED SITES AND DEEP EXCAVATIONS

The National Construction Authority (NCA) is a State Corporation established under the provisions of Section 3 of the National Construction Act No. 41 of 2011. The Authority is mandated to oversee the construction industry and coordinate its development. It is also charged with the responsibility to promote and ensure quality assurance in the construction industry.

The Authority notes with concern the proliferation of abandoned construction sites and deep excavations within and out of urban areas. This poses a safety hazard to the public and is harmful to the environment.

Against this premise and in exercising the powers bestowed upon the Authority under the provisions of Section 23 of the National Construction Authority Act, the Authority hereby orders all developers with ongoing, abandoned or planned construction works with deep excavations exceeding 3.0 meters across the country to submit a geotechnical site investigation report. The report should detail slope stability, monitoring programs and detailed studies of the effects on adjacent structures.

Further, any contractor undertaking works of any such project is required to submit to the Authority a method statement giving details of the method of excavation and the support system to be applied in the course of the works. The method statement submitted must be approved by the project structural engineer.

The Authority hereby serves a notice to developers and contractors with abandoned construction sites and deep excavations within and out of urban areas to undertake the following measures:

- To proceed with the construction works forthwith in line with the conditions of approval and submit the necessary reports to the Authority as required by this notice;
- In absence of plans to continue with the project as envisioned, to take steps to safely dewater and backfill the deep excavations within 30 days from the date of this notice. Upon the lapse of this period, the Authority will recommend to a relevant government agency to take corrective steps at the cost of the respective developer;
- Developers with abandoned construction sites and deep excavations shall present to the Authority a structural integrity report from a structural engineer within a period of 30 days from the date of this notice and a plan to proceed with works. In the absence of the report, the Authority will recommend necessary remedial action including but not limited to demolition and or repossession of the land by the Government of Kenya in line with the conditions of the title.
